Street Sweeping Parking Restrictions

At the July 6, 2021 City Council meeting, the City Council has adopted Street Sweeping Parking Restrictions (OMC Section 4-6.1019) for residents who wish to establish parking restrictions on their street on street sweeping days for the City's street sweepers to thoroughly clean the curbs. Please follow these steps to request street sweeping parking restrictions on your block:

- 1. A survey of the residents on the street shall be conducted by the applicant to determine the level of support.
- 2. To request for street sweeping parking restrictions on your street, use the attached petition forms to gather signatures from neighbors/residents on the same street who support the establishment of parking restrictions. Should you require additional signature forms, please make copies of the form on the last page of this packet. Note that two-thirds (or greater) of the residents supporting the restrictions is required.
- 3. Return the complete and signed petition forms to the address below or submit the petition forms via email at the email address below.
- 4. Should the petition include two-thirds (or greater) of the residents supporting the restrictions, the Executive Director of Public Works will recommend implementing the street sweeping restrictions followed by an agenda report with a Resolution to be presented to the City Council at a regular meeting for approval.
- 5. Should the City Council approve the street sweeping parking restrictions, City staff will install appropriate signage at your street to enforce parking restrictions on the street sweeping day. (Sweeping time frame will be coordinated and determined by Public Works Agency.)
- 6. Following the installation of signage, the Ontario Police Department will enforce the parking restrictions.
