BUILDING DEPARTMENT ELECTRONIC PLAN CHECK (EPC) FILE FORMATTING REQUIREMENTS

<u>This applies to Building Department submittals only.</u> See separate Planning, Engineering, and Fire Dept. formatting requirements as applicable.

- 1) File Types
 - Submitted documents must be in PDF format
 - o PDF Files cannot be secured or locked (use flattened images for professional stamps and signatures instead).
 - o Pages must have the same orientation and page size. (e.g. landscape for PLANS file).
 - o PLANS files shall be first generation vector-based PDFs directly converted from CAD applications in which they were created. Scanned Plans will not be accepted unless the plan sheet is hand drawn.
 - o PDF Portfolios cannot be used as part of your submittal package.
- 2) File Size Limit
 - o The file upload limit is 100 MBs.
 - o If your set of plans are larger. Please try to reduce the file size or the plans will need to be split into separate PDF file parts below the file size limit. For example,
 - 1PC Plans P1,
 - 1PC Plans P2,
 - 1PC Plans P3.... etc.
- 3) File Naming
 - o ALL initial files at the Building Pre-Application (BPA) process shall contain the following prefix and must be named according to the file contents. Such as,
 - 1PC Application
 - 1PC Plans
 - 1PC Structural Calculations (If Applicable)
 - 1PC Geotechnical Report (If Applicable) etc.
 - ALL files for resubmittal shall contain the following prefix and must be named according to the file contents. Such as,
 - 2PC Plans
 - 2PC Building Response Letter
 - 2PC Structural Calculations (If Applicable)
 - 2PC Geotechnical Report (If Applicable) etc.
 - o Any subsequent resubmittal files beyond the 2nd PC must be numbered and named accordingly (i.e. 3PC -, 4PC -, 5PC etc.).
