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MANURE REMOVAL PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Building Department Requirements:

- a. Three (3) sets of plans are required showing the areas of manure to be removed and depth.
- b. Dust control plan.
- c. Yardage of removal by each area.
- d. Contours to be achieved by the proposed manure removal.
- e. All surface drainage devices.
- f. Approvals for exporting the manure. State where the site(s) is/are located.
- g. Two (2) sets of soils/geology report on manure removal.

Engineering Department Requirements:

- 1. Erosion control plan for all work on the site. The plans should address hours of operations, periodic street sweeping, dust control, sand bagging, tracking controls, and all other appropriate erosion control BMP pertinent to the site.
- 2. Truck route, showing the locations of all receiving sites inside and outside City limits.
- 3. Pay a refundable \$10,000 deposit to ensure that all truck routes are kept in a clean and safe condition.
- 4. Obtain a Traffic Control Permit given the size and scope of this operation to ensure that all appropriate traffic control devices are in place in accordance with the CMUTCD. Staff will need to know the precise ingress and egress locations, how many truck trips per day, the requested daily work hours, which will be subject to changes via the permit conditions, the duration of the hauling operation, and the requested haul routes to and from the disposal site.

Planning Department Requirements:

a. Meet the Mitigation Measure of EIR.
