

OVERSIZED VEHICLE PARKING

BEGINNING JULY 1, 2023, TEMPORARY OVERSIZED VEHICLE PARKING PERMITS ARE REQUIRED

OMC 4-6. 1020

The City of Ontario recognizes it's citizens enjoy outdoor activities!

The City Code is designed to provide residents temporary parking to prepare or clean out their RV, oversized vehicle, trailer, or boat for a trip, but also prevent our streets from being used for RV storage.



FAILURE TO COMPLY

A citation may be issued if the code is violated or abused. All vehicles are subject to tow.

Numerous citations may result in a delay in the registration process through the Department of Motor Vehicles.



WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- A valid, City issued parking permit must be displayed on any oversized vehicle, to include buses, trailers, coaches, or RVs, parked on city streets
- An “oversized vehicle” means any vehicle that exceeds twenty feet (20’) in length, or eighty inches (80”) in width or seventy-eight inches (78”) in height, or that weighs more than six thousand (6,000) pounds (gross vehicle weight).
- The vehicle must be parked in front of the residence it belongs to, and cannot be a public safety hazard
- No more than 2 permits shall be issued per calendar month
- Permits will not be issued consecutively, and cannot exceed a 48 hour parking period
- The vehicle must be registered and operable
- Submit your application at least five business days before you wish to park.
- **PERMIT APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED STARTING JUNE 15, 2023**
