- 4. Comfortable clothing should be worn; i.e. sweats, loose jeans and tennis shoes. Business attire such as suits and skirts do not allow enough free movement.
- 5. THIS CLASS IS NOT FOR HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS SUCH AS E.M.T.'s, NURSES OR DOCTORS.
- 6. The minimum age to participate is 14.
