



SULTANA AVENUE STORM DRAIN, SEWER AND STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

In January 2025, the City of Ontario is scheduled to begin construction for the Sultana Avenue Storm Drain, Sewer and Street Improvements Project. The anticipated 18-month project involves the installation of approximately 12,000 feet of storm drain pipe, over 1,500 feet of sewer pipe, new asphalt pavement, rock curb adjustments, tree removal, construction of ADA ramps and the planting of new trees.

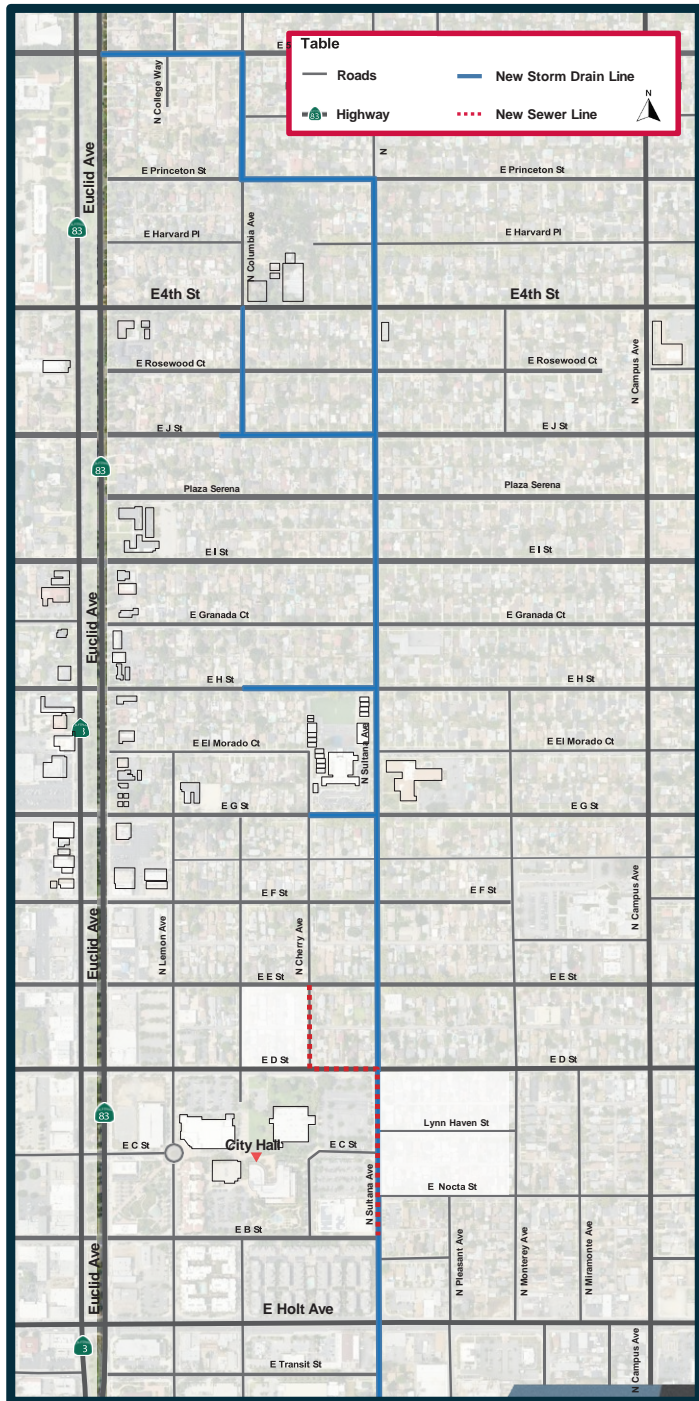
Funded by Measure Q and Sewer Enterprise Funds, the \$17 million improvement project will help accommodate the city's civic center expansion project, enhance drainage during rain events, upgrade sewer lines to increase capacity and provide aesthetic improvements to the community.


WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Construction hours are Monday through Friday, from 7am - 5pm.
- Construction is expected to begin south of Holt Boulevard near Transit Street and move north.
- Block-by-block street closures will be implemented with advance notice provided.
- Increased construction vehicles and/or equipment traffic.
- Temporary driveway restrictions may be necessary.
- Detours, traffic and parking restrictions, and minor traffic delays should be anticipated.
- While noise, dust, vibrations and sewer odors are anticipated, we will make every effort to minimize these effects.
- Sewer service interruptions may be required to connect the new sewer line. Residents may be temporarily asked to reduce flows and avoid flushing toilets during limited hours. Advanced coordination and notice will be provided to impacted properties.
- Information about construction activities and project schedules will be provided to the community throughout the project.
