- 8. Staff Report Director's Report:
 - J. Worden gave the Board an update on the COVID situation, the numbers are going in the wrong direction.
 - Staffing: The newly hired Assistant Curator resigned due to his inability to fulfill the work schedule required for the position. The Museum has started the process to hire a new Assistant Curator, this time the job as a full-time position. The Museum is in the progress of hiring an Administrative Intern, hoping to have them in place by February.
 - Projects: The CIP projects (Built on Water, ADA Bathroom, Carlson Gallery and Offsite Storage) went out to bid as a combined project. The project is scheduled to

begin in the early months of 2021. Museum staff is currently in the middle of planning a move of collection items located on the first floor once offsite collections storage is completed, scheduled for late spring/early summer of 2021. Built on Water is moving along with the design phase and the Museum is working with exhibit lenders.

- Exhibition and Programs: The Museum is doing a lot of work on exhibitions and programs. Law of Nature featuring Artist Rebecca Hamm will open on December 3rd. For 2021, Reflections with Guest Curator, Patricia Woodlin opens January 14th; Art of Survival opens on February 25th and the 11th Biennial Open Art Exhibition opens on May 6th. The Director went over December's programs. The Museum is continuing to partner with other organizations, next year will host programs with Long Road to Freedom, Terra del Sol, Museum of Riverside and Malki Museum.
- The Board can help get the word out to the public about our virtual exhibitions and programs
- Museum staff will do a comprehensive presentation at the January meeting, looking back at what we have done and looking forward to what we have planned.
