- 7. Staff Report: Director's report

Museum Director, John Worden updated the museum board on the roof damage created by a strong windstorm on Monday, June 8, 2020. Several trees were damaged and have been removed. The damaged historic flagpole has not been removed yet. Public Works is collaborating with the Historic Preservation Department, the city arborist and the museum staff on the removal of the flagpole. The city decided to hold off on opening the museum because of the rise in cases of Covid-19. The Curator of Education has been selected and will now undergo a background check. The museum has hired two contractors to assist with the Built-on Water exhibit. John Worden has met with Inland Empire Utilities Agency and is building a relationship with them. The museum will be hiring a part-time Assistant Curator. The museum received funding from the National Endowments for the Arts, Cares Act in the amount of \$50,000. The grant will help fund the Assistant Curator and Curator of Education positions. John Worden introduced the new Community, Life & Culture Officer, Paulina Alverez.

Museum Director, John Worden shared the strategic plan with the museum board. John Worden asked the board members for any feedback. President pro Tem, Rick Caughman said the strategic plan is relevant and is a nice roadmap for the future. Board President, Chris Kueng agreed. Board Member, Ada Lopez thanked everyone for working on the strategic plan and she was happy to hear about the museum receiving the National Endowments for the Arts, Cares Act grant. President pro Tem, Rick Caughman congratulated the museum board for completing the strategic plan and is happy to hear about the grant. Board President, Chris Kueng is happy to see everyone in the council chambers again and he likes the temperature check station provided by the City of Ontario. He is extremely proud of the strategic plan and he especially likes the mission, vision, and values statements. Board President, Chris Kueng enjoyed being a part of the interview process for the Curator of Education. He thanked the museum staff, the Community, Life & Culture Agency, Council Member, Debra Dorst-Porada, Museum Associates President, Leslie Sherwood-James and the museum board.

12. Future Agenda Items:

The museum board recommended field trips for the board and museum staff to local museums comparable to the Ontario Museum of History & Art. President pro Tem, Rick Caughman would like to have an ongoing conversation on the museum's virtual presence.
