B. ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT & DEVELOPMENT PLAN REVIEW FOR FILE NO. PDEV11-019: A Development Plan for the development of a 7,453 square foot auto parts retail store (O'Reilly's Auto Parts) on 0.77 acre site, generally located along the northeast corner of Euclid Avenue and Riverside Drive, within the C1 (Shopping Center Commercial) and EA (Euclid Avenue Overlay) zoning districts.
