Dear Applicant:

Windows are an essential element in terms of architectural characteristic and craftsmanship of a historic building. They are also an important aspect when determining a building's historic significance. Repairing and retaining or restoring original windows are highly desirable, however, replacement may be necessary in special cases.

All proposed window replacements for historic buildings are subject to Planning Department review and requires approval. An administrative approval (a Waiver) may be issued if the existing windows are deteriorated beyond repair and cannot be restored. If determined that window replacement is appropriate, new windows must be compatible with the architectural style of the building and replicate the original window opening, design, style and operation. A good alteration can make a multitude of difference to the value of a historic home and its streetscape.

Please make sure to provide all the items requested in the application packet before visiting the Planning Department counter for processing. Applications that do not meet the minimum requirements will not be accepted.



WINDOW REPLACEMENT

To further assist residential and commercial property owners, contractors, architects and designers, <u>Division 7.01</u>, <u>Historic</u> <u>Preservation</u>, of the City's Development Code lists design guidelines that shall be followed for the preservation, protection, repair or replacement of Historic Windows. **If approved**, **the applicant is responsible for obtaining all required Building Permits prior to the commencement of work**.

SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

The minimum requirements for filing a request for window replacement approval are listed below and shall be submitted through the City's Citizen Portal Access website at https://automation.ontarioca.gov/onlinePermits or in person at the Planning Department located inside Ontario City Hall. Each item below shall be labeled accordingly and when submitted digitally, must be in WORD, PDF or JPEG file format. An application that does not include the following plans and information will not be accepted for processing:

Complete plot plan prepared in 8 ½" x 11" format indicating locations of windows to be replaced. Sample plot plan attached for reference.

☐ Window schedule corresponding with plot plan specifying the window number, existing and proposed size, existing and proposed material, window type, and whether the window is in a bedroom. **Sample window** schedule attached for reference. Clear photographs of existing windows proposed for replacement. Photographs should be labeled for easy reference with plot plan and window schedule.

Evaluation of existing window condition by a qualified professional familiar with the restoration of historic windows.

Brochure and/or photographs of proposed replacement windows indicating window manufacturer, series, material, color, hardware and grille specifications.


